



Frequently asked questions and the answers.

Breakfast Club	
Where do we park and drop off for Breakfast Club?	Park in Dark Lane or bottom carpark and use the gates opposite the recycling centre, to walk up to the Junior Reception. Or park respectively in Sherwood's Rise and make your way to the Junior Reception. You CAN NOT park in the staff car park for Breakfast Club drop off. This includes if someone is waiting in the car. The Staff carpark is strictly prohibited for Breakfast Club, unless you have a disabled badge.
Does my child have to have breakfast?	It is entirely up to each child/family. Some children have breakfast at Fusion, some have a little bit at home and then some with us.
What breakfast options are there?	Water, milk, a range of cereals (no chocolate). A range of breaded options; muffins, crumpets, croissants, brioche, toast, malt loaf, pancakes, waffles and smoothies.
When can I drop off my child/ren?	The session starts at 7:45am. You can drop off at 7:30am for an extra fee.
What do the children do when they are at Breakfast Club?	We have access to hall, dining room, courtyard, and outside area. Children have free access to a range of toys and resources that they can use as they wish. All self-choice and self-selected. At 8:30am all children go into the hall for a group game and registration before School starts at 8:45am.
Do I have to sign my child/ren in?	No- you say goodbye at the glass doors in the Junior foyer and the children sign themselves in, this promotes independence and responsibility.
Can my child/ren walk up to Breakfast Club on their own?	Unfortunately, NOT, we must see all parents/carers at drop off as we may need to speak to you
When does Breakfast finish?	8:30am
How do children get dropped off to school?	Juniors via the inside of the Junior building. Infants are walked over to the Infant school with Fusion staff and delivered to their classroom from the inside of the building.
What happens if my child leaves something at Breakfast Club?	At the end of the Breakfast Club session, the trolley or benches/ boxes where belongings are put are checked as they are needed to be used by School. Any Junior belongings will be given into the School office or handed to the child's class. Any Infant belongings will be given back to the child before they leave the Junior dining room.
After School Club	
How do my child/ren get to Fusion?	Junior children walk to the Junior dining room and meet Fusion staff. Infant children sit on the carpet in their classroom and Fusion staff collect directly from each classroom.
Where do we pick up from After School Club and where do we park?	You CAN park in the staff carpark for After School Club pick up. Please DO NOT access the site from the gates around the field. Collection is from the Infant/Junior dining room (Fusion's entrance), dependant on your collection time. Press the buzzer and we will bring your child/ren out to you.
What time is dinner?	Dinner is at 4/4:15pm and usually lasts for 30/45 mins.
Can the children go to extra-curricular clubs (school led run clubs, sports, choir) after School and then go to Fusion?	Yes- children who attend an extra-curricular club will be sent/brought to us by the teacher/ leader when the clubs finish. Juniors meet in the dining room and a member of Fusion staff will be waiting for them. If a club finishes after 4:15pm, we cannot guarantee food.
Why do I have to know my family password and maybe requested to show ID at collection?	This is part of our Safeguarding Policy and Procedure and is in place to Safeguard the children in our care. Staff must get to know all new parents. Please do NOT tell your child/ren our password.



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<p>My child has a club after Fusion (scouts, brownies, gym, cricket) can they get changed at Fusion?</p>	<p>Yes, no problem- it is the children's responsibility to get themselves changed, making sure their uniform is in their bag! We also suggest getting changed after dinner, for obvious reasons!</p>
<p>Do I have to sign my child/ren out?</p>	<p>We will sign your child/ren out as parents are not allowed in the building. We use GMT to write the time collected and by who. This is part of our Safeguarding, so we know who has left the premises, ratios and know who has collected your child/ren.</p>
<p>Does my child have to do the activities?</p>	<p>Yes to the well-being activity as this is the way we register the children. This lasts for a max of 10 mins and is based on the children's interests of a topic. It is a good opportunity to allow children to reset from School and be ready for their Fusion session.</p> <p>The children can choose whether they take part in the activities but on some occasions, it may be necessary for all children to join in due to circumstances, environmental changes, staffing or to protect the children.</p> <p>The children at every available opportunity will get to have free play and they can choose how they spend their time (PARS Playwork approach)</p>
<p>What happens if my child leaves something at After School Club?</p>	<p>If it is named we pop it back in their classrooms, if it is un-named we keep hold of the item for a few days in our lost property to see if it gets claimed. If it doesn't get claimed after a week, we add it to the School's lost property.</p>
<p>Collecting scooters/ bikes</p>	<p>Please let us know if your child/ren have a scooter and we can try and remind them, but ultimately it is their responsibility.</p> <p>When the gates/outside area is locked, we cannot go back out there, so please understand this.</p>
